	As of January 1, 2024 the Rockefeller Institute at University of Albany, the NYS Association of Town Clerks (NYSTCA) and NYS Association of City and Village Clerks (NYSACVC) have made the decision to part ways due to programming goals and cost concerns.
	NYSTCA & NYSACVC are working together to create a IIMC institute that is run by clerks for clerks bringing the programming back to essential tasks/information relevant to the role of Clerks, instead of professional development only. Professional development will certainly be a component of the institute, but not its sole focus.
	To put together a strong program the difficult decision was made to postpone the new institute until July of 2025.
